FIRST ANNUAL SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

We are excited to offer you and your middle school student an opportunity to continue his or her studies on a part-time basis over a six-week span during the summer of 2009. Classes in Mathematics, Science, Language Arts and Social Studies are available to students who have completed the 6th, 7th, and 8th grades. The Glencoe and ABeka curriculum presented in 2008-2009 will be continued and expanded to provide each student advanced preparation for the 2009-2010 school year. Participating students will receive an additional quarter of academic credit to enhance their grade point averages.

Classes will be held each Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday beginning on Tuesday, June 30th, and ending on Thursday, August 6th. The daily class schedule will be as follows:

Mrs. Ephraim's classroom will be open for students to arrive no earlier than 7:30 am each class day.

Mathematics – 8:00 to 9:30 am; the teacher is Mrs. Ephraim

Science – 9:30 to 11:00 am; the teacher is Mrs. Ephraim

Lunch & Play Break – 11:00 am to 12:00 pm; supervision will be provided by Mrs. Ephraim & Ms. Hendricks

Language Arts – 12:00 to 1:30 pm; the teacher is Ms. Hendricks

Social Studies – 1:30 to 3:00 pm; the teacher is Ms. Hendricks

Tutoring help may be available between 3:00 & 5:00 pm. More details will follow if there is interest.

Students not enrolled in tutoring must be picked-up between 3:00 and 3:15 pm each class day.

Students may enroll in one, two, three, or all four enrichment courses. Students not enrolled in a given course will not be supervised while that class is in session, therefore, they must arrive and be picked-up promptly to ensure their safety. All students enrolled in Science may stay for the lunch & play break, but if not enrolled in Language Arts, must be picked-up by 12:00 pm. All students enrolled in Language Arts but not in Science are welcome to come for the lunch & play break beginning at 12:00 pm. There will be limited homework on Tuesday and Wednesdays, with the lightest homework assignments (if any) on Thursdays, to allow for long, stress-free summer weekends and plenty of family time.

The fee for these enrichment classes will be \$25 per subject per week, or \$150 per subject for the 6-week session. There will be no charge for early arrival if the student is enrolled in Mathematics, and there will be no charge for supervision during the lunch & play break if the student is enrolled in Science and/or Language Arts. The fee for tutoring after 3:00 pm will be announced later when need and interest are determined.
